

## **Mount Royal Academy Curriculum Mapping with Holy Apostles AA and BA Programs**

Holy Apostles College & Seminary will provide a tuition reduction to all Mount Royal Academy students who register for courses under its TakeCredit! program prior to their graduation from high school. The terms of the arrangement are simply as follows:

The Mount Royal Academy student who has completed 10<sup>th</sup> grade but has not yet graduated can register for courses independently of Mount Royal Academy (during the summers or during the school year). The tuition reduction would be 1/3 the cost of normal tuition.

Students may register for courses the summer of their graduation at the same reduced tuition but will pay full tuition for any courses they take in the fall semester and subsequent semesters following their high school graduation.

### **Total costs break down as follows:**

Up to 20 courses during high school or in the summer immediately following high school graduation would be available at 1/3 the HACS tuition (which is \$320 per credit hour in the spring of 2016). Total cost = \$6,400.

An additional 20 courses following high school beginning with the fall term immediately following high school graduation will be available at full tuition (which is \$320 per credit hour in the spring of 2016). Total cost = \$19,200.

Total cost of the AA program = as little as \$6,400 depending upon how much coursework can be completed during high school and in the summer immediately following.

Total cost of the BA program = as little as \$25,600 depending upon how much coursework can be completed during high school

If students complete only 7 courses at Holy Apostles at \$320 from the summer following their sophomore year to their summer following their senior year (that is, taking one college course per term – 10<sup>th</sup> grade summer, 11<sup>th</sup> grade fall, 11<sup>th</sup> grade spring, 11<sup>th</sup> grade summer, 12<sup>th</sup> grade fall, 12<sup>th</sup> grade spring, 12<sup>th</sup> grade summer), the cost will be \$2,240. Add an additional 33 courses at normal tuition of \$960, and the cost will be \$31,680. The total cost of the BA degree would be \$33,920.

All factors considered, the total cost of the BA program ranges from \$25,600 to \$33,920.
